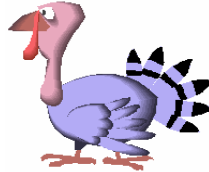
Motorcycle Helmets Required

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by club president, Tom Batchelor at 7:08 p.m.

The minutes of the October 6, 2005 meeting were read and accepted by the members present.

The Treasury report was read and accepted by the members present.

Old Business:

-Discussion regarding the issue of allowing out of state riders to compete for the Texas State Series title led to a motion by Chuck Howard to allow non-resident riders to compete for the Texas State Series title for one a year probation. Keith Lewis seconded the motion. The members present voted and the motion was carried. Tom Batchelor will present this decision to the State Series council members as a proposal for this year's competition changes. Tom will report back to the club with the council's final decision.

-Trials master fees were discussed next. As of this meeting date, trials masters receive \$30 per day for a two-day event. They receive \$25 for a one-day event. Danny Aguirre made a motion that the fees be increased to \$100 per day for a two-day event and \$50 for a one-day event. The motion failed to receive a second. The motion was denied.

Old Business Continued:

-Further discussion led to a motion proposed by Larry Doyle that the trials master would be reimbursed \$50 per day per event. Chuck Howard seconded the motion. It was voted upon and the motion carried.

-The issue of reimbursing the trials master of a national event was brought up again for further discussion. Tom Batchelor stated that the officers needed time to discuss this with those that will receive the funds and made a motion to "table" this issue until the next meeting. Chuck Howard seconded the motion. No one opposed, so the motion carried.

New Business:

-Newsletter is ready for December. The gate code is needed for Chris Denney to publish in the newsletter. Tom Batchelor will get that code for Chris.

-Larry Doyle and Kerry Duckworth made a request to get support from the NTTA club for the November 20th event at Bridgeport by providing supplies used to set up an event. Supplies such as punches, flagging, loop markers, red and blue ribbon, etc. are needed. They made it clear that the funds raised at this event would go to support the Texas Youth Nationals Fund. Chuck Howard made a motion for the NTTA to donate supplies to this event. Chris Denney seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and passed.

-NTTA Christmas party will be held at the home of Kathy and Richard Billings of McKinney on December 10, 2005. They will be given a budget of \$400-\$500. The directions and further information will be given to the newsletter editor to publish. Layne Nelson made a motion to accept this date and location. Chuck Howard seconded the motion. It was voted on and passed.

-A calendar of events put on a poster for the purpose of promoting our club events was discussed. Posters need to be distributed by everyone when they are completed. Lynne Duval will handle coordinating this effort.

-Keith Lewis made a motion that a new banner be purchased to be posted at the Red River Motorcycle Area giving information about the event occurring that specific weekend with information about the location and times. This banner will always travel with the "box". Larry Doyle seconded this motion. It was voted upon and passed.

New Business Continued:

-A report regarding the NATC meeting held the last week in October in Colorado was given by the NTTA representative, Ramon Aguirre. Tishmingo, OK will host a national event in April. The Women's and High School classes have been assigned new lines to ride this year. Check the NATC website for further details. Entry fees for the nationals will increase this year from \$50 to \$60 for a pre-entry. A late entry will still cost \$100 and that full amount will go directly to the club hosting the event.

-An announcement was made regarding Dave Seeley being inducted into the Trials Hall of Fame (listed on the internet only). Kathy Billings, his daughter, will be writing a brief history about Dave's involvement in Trials.

-The Trials Training Center will be hosting a world round and a national event next year in Tennessee. Dan Brown has asked the NTTA to host a section and judge that particular section. Dan said he needed four judges per day from our club. The national event will be held on Friday, May 18, 2006. The world round competition will be held on May 19 and 20, 2006, all in the same weekend. No decisions were made as to making a commitment to host and judge a section for the national and world round at the Trials Training Center.

There being no further business, the motion was made to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
