### **TECH TALK:**

Grip installation techniques from the membership we gleaned the following methods of installing new grips;

Justin – spray paint (flat black dries quickest)  
Frank – gasoline (not premix and don't forget to safety wire afterwards)  
Chris – lacquer thinner, Gas-ca-Cinch adhesive or 3M adhesive (ditto on the safety wire)
