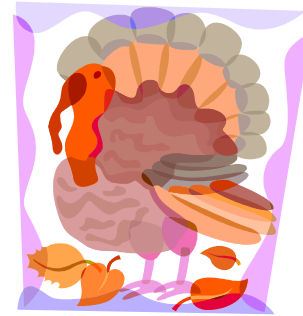

Watch for state road 22 veering off to the left (west)... the state trooper should be having breakfast at the diner on the left... go west about 1.5 miles and look on the right for a rock wall that says "Lake Estates". Turn north on Lake Estates Rd., left at the dumpsters. Follow the ribbons about 2.3 miles down the gravel road, the parking is on the right at a private residence.
