Dependant children of a competitor may ride at discounted rates, with the purchase of a full price entry fee. Registration fee for the 1st and 2nd dependant child is half price - \$12.50 per day (*\$10.00 per day pre-entry*). Registration for additional dependant children is \$5.00 per day. The standard gate fee still applies per day, per motorcycle.

Requirements:

- DOT, Snell or NATC approved motorcycle helmet
- All riders may be asked to judge, and are expected to do so
- All riders must attend the riders meeting, for possible judging assignment

In Houston: Beltway 8 (Sam Houston Toll Road) circumnavigates the city. From the northeast corner of Beltway 8, go south for approximately 3 miles, then turn west onto the "North Lake Houston Parkway" and continue for 2.1 miles, to the Rio Bravo entrance, on the left.

From Austin: Take US 290 East to the NW corner of Houston. Exit onto Beltway 8 North which will soon turn to the East. Continue on Beltway 8 East, all the way to the NE corner of Houston, where the Beltway will turn to the south. Once headed south on the Beltway, go approximately 3 miles, then turn west (right) onto the "North Lake Houston Parkway" and continue for 2.1 miles, to the Rio Bravo entrance, on the left.

From Dallas: Take I-45 South, into Houston. On the north side of town, exit onto Beltway 8 East. Continue on Beltway 8 East, to the NE corner of Houston, where the Beltway will turn to the south. Once headed south on the Beltway, go approximately 3 miles, then turn west (right) onto the "North Lake Houston Parkway" and continue for 2.1 miles, to the Rio Bravo entrance, on the left.

ALL - Once headed west on North Lake Houston Parkway, proceed for 2.1 miles, to the entrance to Rio Bravo, on the left.

Note: Prior to the road for Rio Bravo, you will pass the "Houston Motorsports Park", on your left. Get ready, because you are about to pass the unmarked entrance Rio Bravo!!! Watch for a bridge up ahead. Now LITERALLY, just prior to the bridge, you will turn left onto a dirt road which winds through the trees.
