Land Fees:

\$10.00 Gate/Insurance fee, per person, per day (competing or not)
Competing trials bikes ONLY, permitted on the property.
**** NO ATV's, MX bikes, Enduro bikes, etc. (Strictly enforced!)**

Entry Fees:

\$ Free Sr. Cadet
\$15.00 Per Day (Rookie, Vintage & Women) ¹
\$20.00 Per Day (Non-Competition - In state or Out of State) ¹
\$30.00 Per Day (All other classes) - *Pre-Entry by mail is \$25.00 per day, if postmarked by the February 25th deadline*

Additional Discounts:

Dependant children of a competitor may ride at discounted rates, with the purchase of ONE full price entry fee. Registration fee for the 1st dependant child is half price - \$15.00 per day (*\$12.50 per day pre-entry*). Registration for additional dependant children is \$7.50 per day. The standard gate/insurance fee still applies per day, per person, regardless of any other discounts. (*May not be combined with already discounted fees above ¹*)

Requirements:

- NATC approved helmets **MUST** be worn while on your bike. No Exceptions!
- Gate/Insurance fee will be paid at the gate. Rider or not, everyone must pay to receive a wristband, allowing property access. (**Specify trials for lower \$10.00 rate!**)
- Prior to riding, you **MUST** complete the videotaped release process, yielding a 2nd wristband, identifying you as a competitor.
- Event sign-up **REQUIRES** both wristbands, so do your videotape first!
- There is a vintage MX event the same weekend, and our insurance agreement allows only trials bikes, ridden by videotaped competing riders, on the property.
- AMA membership is not required for this event.
- All riders may be asked to judge, and are expected to do so.
- All riders must attend the riders meeting, for possible judging assignment.

Camping:

\$15.00 for the weekend, or \$10.00 per single night.

Only primitive camping (no power or water) is available. Contained campfires allowed in the main parking area only.

Access to the property will be available starting Friday at 2:00 PM. If you arrive late in the evening, and find the gate locked, call Kim McCandless at 281-229-1917, for entry. Kim will be camping on the property, and will come open the gate.

In Houston: Beltway 8 (Sam Houston Toll Road) circumnavigates the city. From the northeast corner of Beltway 8, go south for approximately 3 miles, then turn west (right) onto the "North Lake Houston Parkway".

From Austin: Take US 290 East to the NW corner of Houston. Exit onto Beltway 8 North which will soon turn to the East. Continue on Beltway 8 East, all the way to the NE corner of Houston, where the Beltway will turn to the south. Once headed south on the Beltway, go approximately 3 miles, then turn west (right) onto the "North Lake Houston Parkway".

From Dallas: Take I-45 South, into Houston. On the north side of town, exit onto Beltway 8 East. Continue on Beltway 8 East, to the NE corner of Houston, where the Beltway will turn to the south. Once headed south on the Beltway, go approximately 3 miles, then turn west (right) onto the "North Lake Houston Parkway".

ALL - Once headed west on "North Lake Houston Parkway", proceed for 2.1 miles, to the entrance to Rio Bravo, on the left.

Note: Prior to the road for Rio Bravo, you will pass the "Houston Motorsports Park", on your left. Get ready, because you are about to reach the entrance to Rio Bravo!!! Watch for a bridge up ahead. LITERALLY, just prior to the bridge, you will turn left, through the big red double gates.
