Turn north; travel approximately 15-miles to the main entrance to the Red River Motorcycle Park. Pass the main gate \_-mile to gravel county road at old windmill, Turn right to 3<sup>rd</sup> gate, follow gravel road to green metal gate. Follow the pink ribbon to pit area.
